Paths connect garden rooms on this half acre block, with benches to sit and admire each area. Clipped hedges of box, rosemary and lonicera link the gardens. Roses, azaleas, begonias, fuchsia and annuals add to the appeal. Ornamental trees of maple, magnolia, cherry, ginko, crab-apple, conifers and cupressus are throughout the garden

Jarnac is open for the first time in 32 years and this 3.3 hectare garden features a large variety of rainforest trees. Walk down the winding driveway through a forest sprinkled with staghorns and orchids and take the challenging trail through the orchard of avocado and many fruit trees.

**6 PUCK LANE** 48 MacDonnell Rd, Eagle Heights



A pleasant walk up a tree covered lane to enter a hidden woodland oasis adjoining Joalah National Park. 38 different Japanese Maples together with camellias, azaleas and many more beautiful plants happily growing amongst handmade rock steps and sculptures and a lovely Japanese Garden. All lovingly created by the owner.

**7 THE HAVEN** 1 Areca Court, Eagle Heights



(Corner of Contour Road)  
This Garden has been remodelled to create a plant lovers haven. Established trees form the base for new plantings of Japanese Maples and Camellias underplanted with many vireyas, rhododendrons, hellebores, fuchsias and cliveas plus lots of perennials, annuals and bulbs to add seasonal colour. A fern and orchid house with easy access.
